Since we moved to the town of over a year ago, my wife and I have witnessed the mistreatment of dogs owned and boarded by . (our neighbor). The humane society was called in last fall because the twelve or so dogs owned/boarded by him where not being fed and cared for properly. At that time, (Town Health Officer) stated that Common was given a warning and was told that the dogs had to be given fresh food and water daily, and that the area around the dogs had to be kept clean.

Along with not feeding them properly, he has not cleared any snow around the dogs houses or removed their waste. has not even been living at the house were the dogs are kept. There is no electricity, running water, or telephone service at the house. I am appalled that someone can board dogs on a piece of property without the proper care and facilities necessary. I hope someone at your office will find it in their heart to put a stop to this. Like I said before, he has been warned already by your office last fall, and from what I've been told, he has a track record for mistreating his animals. Thanks in advance for your help.
