I met with the complainer in his case at [REDACTED]. He is the owner of [REDACTED] Ave where the subject resides. He stated the subject [REDACTED] had rented the ground floor apartment and moved away approximately one month ago. Subject had left her dog in the apartment but was coming back to feed it. The owner stated he had not seen anyone at the apartment for the last two days. Through an open window I viewed the apartment and saw no signs of food or water. The furnishings in the apartment were tipped and torn with feces and urine through the apartment. The owner signed a permission to enter form and along with Animal Services I entered and removed the dog. Inside of [REDACTED] dog placed on hold for B.L.E. A Notice To Comply was issued to the floor informing subject of the entrance and how to contact the undersigned. Dog removed to Brooklyn Shelter with a request for a vet assessment.
