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**BY THE NEW YORK STATE POLICE ALONG WITH NECESSARY ASSISTANCE.**

You are hereby directed to search and seize the following property and evidence, drugs, and other items used or related to the fighting business or otherwise prohibited, all animal fighting and training equipment (horseballs, boxing sticks, weight scales, etc.), phone records, computer equipment and other data storage devices, photographs, negatives, videotaped film, audio medical records, animal fighting publications, mail, telephone, publications, hypodermic needles, dog training records, address and phone books and other property in order that the evidence may be preserved to be used in the prosecution of a violation of the laws of the State of New York.

This warrant shall be executed between the hours of 6:00AM and 9:00PM.

This warrant shall be executed no more than ten (10) days after the date of its issuance and any property seized pursuant hereto, shall be returned and delivered to the court without unnecessary delay.
