The property is further described as having a red in color barn with a brown wooden addition with beige trim which is located to the left rear of the residence as you face the residence.

Property that tends to demonstrate that an offense was committed were specifically, dogs, cats, or any other animals having been examined by a licensed veterinarian and deemed unhealthy or living in unhealthy conditions, and to authorize any of said animals which had been certified by a veterinarian surgeon, duly licensed by the state of New York in writing, to be so seized, diseased, disabled, or injured as to be unfit for any useful purpose, which said animals said veterinarian surgeon believes to be suffering pain or serious discomfort. Said Euthanasia to be performed in accordance with accepted humane means and procedures. These animals constitute evidence that the offense of failure to provide proper sustenance 1 section 265 of the Agriculture and Markets law 1 and animals improperly confined or kept 1 section 267 of the Agriculture and Markets law 1 had been committed.
